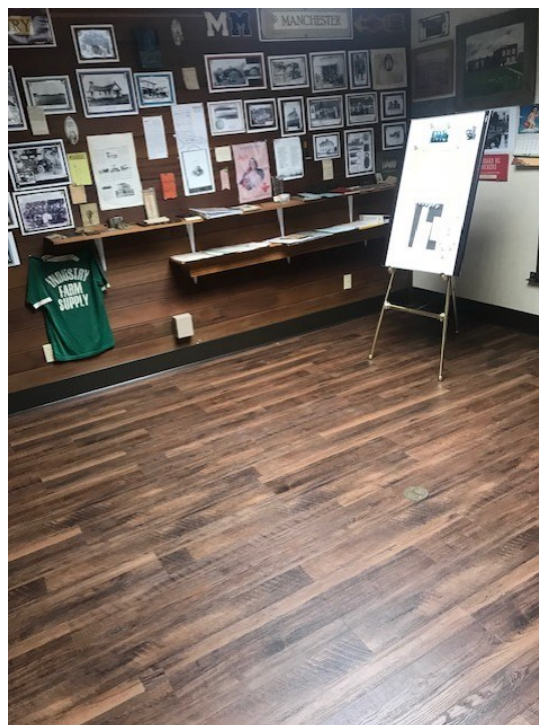

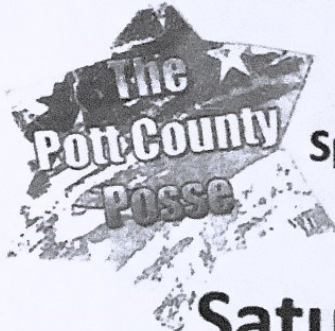
## *Talking History with Verl Coup...*

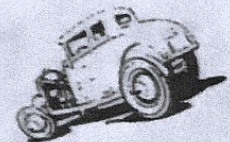
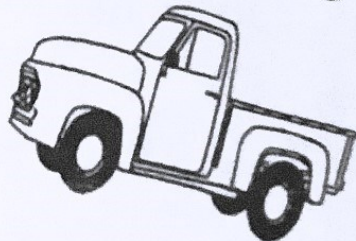
